



Prices & payment – Abisko Scientific Research Station (Abisko naturvetenskapliga station, ANS)

All prices below are given excluding VAT (exklusive moms).

Accommodation prices

The prices below are given per bed per night (from 2019-01-01). Single use of a double room, when available, doubles the prices below.

Bench fee

A separate bench fee, for the use of the station facilities, is paid only by visitors not staying at ANS and not related to SITES. This fee is SEK 70 per day.

Labs, offices, and storage

There is no extra charge for the use of labs and offices for accepted projects. The same goes for storing of equipment, instruments, or samples, as long as a research project is ongoing.

Car hire

The price per kilometre is SEK 3 (including fuel), plus a daily fee is SEK 100.

Transportation by boat

Within the Abisko Basin of Lake Torneträsk, a journey to the other side costs SEK 500, irrespective of the number of passengers or amount of cargo.



Technical services

When service provided by a technician is considered minor, there is no extra charge for it. However, if the support takes more than a couple of hours, the cost is SEK 2100 per day and technician

Catering

If you need catering for a conference, course etc., this has to be arranged by yourself (there are several caterers available in the Abisko area). Catering will be billed directly from the caterer to the organizer.

Payment

The principle is “one project, one PI, one season, one invoice”. This means that the PI of a given research project, or organizer of a conference, field course etc. will receive an invoice covering all the costs pertaining to that “project” in that season. The invoice will be sent out some time after the project has ended (for the season). Of course, the invoice will be based on a specification listing e.g. who has stayed in what room when, and any extra services agreed upon and provided by the station.
